

## SEW FROM THE HEART STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Class: **Quick Quilts Club: Tote Bag**

CLASS DESCRIPTION: Everyone needs a bag to tote stuff, whether you go trick or treating or not. This bag is reversible and can be made from a charm pack. (A charm pack is 40 squares of 5 x 5" fabric from a collection.) Select baby fabric for new moms, floral fabric for gardeners, sewing-themed fabric for quilters, golf fabric for golfers....there is no limit to what you can create! If the Halloween treat tote is too small for you, just cut 6" or 7" squares instead of using the 5" squares. (Cut 8 dark, 8 medium, 8 light and 8 focus fabric, all the same size).

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **Pattern "Schlep Bag" by Carol Coski (available from teacher, \$8)**
- **1 charm pack (Halloween or other fabric)**
- **1/8 yard or 1 FQ fabric for handles AND**
- **1/8 yard Pellon fusible fleece or other batting for handles,**
- **OR 1½ yard strap webbing for handles (can be 1" or 1½" wide)**
- **Rotary cutter and mat**
- **12" ruler**
- **Thread for piecing**
- **Matching or contrasting thread for topstitching**
- **Yellow head or flower head pins**
- **Optional: small travel iron and pressing mat**

**NOTE: if you wish to embroider a name on the front of the bag, please call or email me before class date and I will give you instructions.**

Feet Required: #37 or 57, #1 or other zig-zag foot, walking foot optional.

Knee lift is helpful if you have one.

Basic Sewing Supplies: Yes\_x\_\_\_ No\_\_\_ *This includes: Good quality fabric scissors, small scissors or thread nips, straight pins, 6" seam gauge or ruler, seam ripper, fabric marker, assorted machine needles, pen and paper for notes, any other items you commonly use.
