CLASS DESCRIPTION: Welcome to the Quick Quilt Club! This club will utilize jelly rolls, layer cakes, charms and other "pre-cuts" to make selecting and cutting your fabrics easier. Layer Cakes are collections of **forty** 10x10" fabric squares which coordinate. This project is from the book Layer Cake, Jelly Roll and Charm Quilts and the technique you'll learn is making hourglass blocks. The finished quilt is 72 x 80".

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **Book: Layer Cake, Jelly Roll and Charm Quilts by Pam & Nicky Lintott (pp. 36-41 called "Old Gold") required**
- **1 layer cake**
- **1 jelly roll**
- **No border or binding fabric is needed**
- **Backing 80 x 88" (4 1/3 yards)**
- **Batting 80 x 88"**
- **Rotary cutter with new blade**
- **Small cutting mat**
- **Ruler 2½" wide x 18" or 24" long**
- **Cotton or poly piecing thread, neutral color**
- **Thread for quilting (may select later)**
- **Optional: small craft or travel iron and pressing mat...a huge time-saver!**

To save time, please do the following before class (jelly roll cutting directions are on page 38, column 1):

1. **Choose 8 light strips and set aside for border (pin a note on them to label)**
2. **Choose 4 dark strips for the sashing squares, and cross-cut each into 2½" squares, and put into a plastic bag**
3. **Take 25 strips and cross-cut into 9" (ie. 9x 2½" ) rectangles and place in a bag**
4. **Bring ALL your leftover scraps and strips to class!**

**If you are a new quilter and cannot do the cutting at home I will help you in class.**

Feet Required: #37 or 57, walking foot, BSR if desired for quilting

Single-hole throat plate and knee lift are really helpful.
