CLASS DESCRIPTION: Students will learn how to transform a recycled man's necktie into a unique scarf-like necklace. These easy-to-make, trendy accessories make ideal holiday gifts.

PREREQUISITE (If any):

SUPPLIES REQUIRED: (Be sure to purchase early)

- **1 clean man's necktie (silk or polyester) (Note: If your tie needs to be cleaned, carefully unstitch it, remove interfacing and facings, and gently hand wash in dish-washing detergent. Lay flat to dry and press with iron.). (Note: Facings and interfacings may be discarded or used for another project.)**
- **1 spool all-purpose polyester thread in a color matching dominant color of neck tie. (Note: Choose a color that will recede when stitched.)**
- **6" piece of solid-color silk in a contrasting color for yo-yo embellishment.**
- **One three-quarter inch decorative button**
- **Hand-sewing needle**
- **If you want to incorporate a chain into your accessory, you will need a 9" decorative chain; small toggle closure and several jump rings to match chain finish. If you own flat-nose jewelry pliers, bring them to use for jump rings.**
- **Teacher will have kits available for purchase at class. There will be two types of kits available: (1) Kit includes: Tie, contrasting silk for embellishment, decorative button, and spool of all purpose thread (Cost \$18); (2) Kit includes: Tie, contrasting silk for embellishment, decorative button, chain, toggle closure and jump rings (Cost \$21).**

(If you own an Extra-Large and Large Clover Quick yo-yo maker, bring them to class. Teacher will have them to use during class for those that don't own these instruments.)
