HEXAGONS ENGLISH PAPER PIECING



It's usually thought of as being done in more "traditional" fabrics but anything goes - Kaffes, batiks, 30's etc. Simply make it your own.

The finished squares can be assembled in lots of different ways, creating interesting blocks. Come join the creative fun!




