

Edge to Edge Quilting with your embroidery module

Book: Edge to Edge Quilting

- Sewing machine, embroidery module, power cord, foot pedal, and embroidery foot # 9 or # 26
- Quilter's Dream *Request* cotton batting-craft or crib size
- (2) pieces Tearaway stabilizer- to fit mega, maxi, or jumbo hoop
- Black or dark color thread
- Thread that will show up well on fabric
- Marking pen -- can be a fine tip sharpie
- Scissors for cutting fabric
- Thread snips
- Tweezers (optional but helpful with bobbin)
- Bobbins with good quality bobbin
- Clover double sided ½" Basting tape
- 1 yard Solid colored cotton fabric for quilt top
- 1 yard Solid colored cotton fabric for quilt back
- 12" Ruler (approximately)
- Chalk pencil
- Quilter's safety pins
- Personal USB stick

Getting Ready For Class: Make a quilt sandwich with the top, back and batting material. Leave selvage on fabric. Pin together with basting pins. You can leave a 13" column down the center from selvage to selvage unpinned. The first column will be stitched down the center of the quilt sandwich.
