## **Class Description:**

## **Required Supplies:**

- A working sewing machine with the ability to do a zigzag. Also the foot pedal and power cord.
- Thread for construction. Can be either all purpose of a poly decorative thread. Rayon thread is not recommended.
- Cotton clothesline
- Scissors that can cut the clothesline.
- Size 90 or 100 topstitch needles depends on thread choice.
- Sewing Pins the longer the better. Also really thin ones are not a good choice because they will bend.

## **Optional Supplies:**

- An Open Toe Embroidery Foot
- Any other supplies that you like to have
