



**Proceedings of the City Council Meeting**  
**Special Meeting**  
Williamsburg, Kansas  
March 7, 2016  
7:30pm

The City of Williamsburg Kansas met in Public Hearing on March 7, 2016. Mayor Horne and City Council Members present were Council Member Worden, Council Member Norton, Council Member Stover, Council Member Rhoads and Council Member Tipton. Minutes were taken by Dealy Sims.

Guest present were Elston Horne, Sam Johnson, Commissioner Howard, Lou Coppoc, JR Harris, Fran Bennett, Kenny Messick, Shoeb Uddin, and Bob Hosack.

Meeting called to order 7:30 pm by Mayor Horne.

Mayor Horne thanked everyone for coming this evening and explained the topics of the meeting. Public Hearing for the application to be submitted to the US Department of Agriculture, Rural Development.

Mayor Horne read the two publications that were published in the paper. He then asked the public for any questions or comments. Mr. Harris inquired to why the City was putting the pipe liner in all the pipes instead of just the ones that were bad. Mayor Horne informed Mr. Harris that it was recommended from the Engineer, BG Consultants. Mayor Horne asked Mr. Johnson if he could give a little more of an explanation to Mr. Harris. Mr. Johnson said that they were recommending it because they want to make sure that this will last for many years to come. If they didn't do all of the pipes now and something happen in a couple years it wasn't guaranteed to have the funding available. Right now the City is qualified to have funding assistance and so it really just made sense to take care of it all now. He also informed Mr. Harris that the lining has a 75 year life span if installed correctly. They will be conducting a CCTV after installation to make sure that there is no defects or issues and that it was properly installed. Mr. Messick inquired if this was including a separate pipe on the North side of town so that the double pumping will not continue. Mr. Johnson informed Messick that yes it does include that and went into specifics on the pumping. No other questions or comments were made.

Council Member Tipton made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Seconded by Council Member Norton. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Horne then closed the public hearing at 7:41 pm.
