**Shop Local...** We have some of the best businesses in Northern Utah! They are clean, offer friendly service, are well-stocked, and we have restaurants that are state icons. When we shop locally it shows our loyalty to our local businesses and it not only helps these businesses, but it also encourages other businesses to locate in our community as well as helps to fund improvements within our community. Call the police as soon as possible to report suspicious activity. Call your friends and neighbors from time to time to check on them. This will not only help to create a system of safety within our neighborhoods, but it will also strengthen friendships. Let's send a loud message that we protect our own and do our part to keep criminals out of our city.
