Uses 6 of the March 22nd block Plus 6 - 1" Honeycombs

A honeycomb, like a hexagon has six sides and equal lengths on all sides.

A 1" honeycomb measures 1"x1"x1"x1"x1"x1", but has a 90 degree angle on two opposing ends.
