## KT Layered Patchwork Option

(/) cut square in half once diagonally to yeild 2 triangles

## Assembly

1. Layer a C-light triangle on each Adark square, right sides up, aligning corners; glue in place. Topstitch $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (6) C/E half squares.
2. Add (2) D-dark triangles to light sides of $C / E$ half square; press toward $D$.
3. Piece the large $A$-light triangles and $C / E / D$ segment together to create a pieced half square. Make (6) Unit \#1 that measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
4. Lay out the (6) Unit \#1 with (3) B-light squares, as shown, in 9-patch. Sew block together in rows; press toward corners and center $B$.

Make (1) Cat's Cradle block that measures $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
