## Assembly

1. Layer (2) B-light \#1 triangles over each $C$-dark rectangles, right sides up with corners aligning; glue in place. Topstitch $1 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread.
2. Add an E-light \#2 rectangle to top of each star point unit; press toward $E$. Make (4) star point units that measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square each.
3. Layer an F-light \#2 triangle over each of (8) D-dark squares; glue in place. Topstitch $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from bias edge of triangles with coordinating cotton thread.
4. Sew (2) layered half squares and (2) plain $D$-dark squares together in a 4-patch, as shown, to create a corner unit. Make (4) corner units that measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square each.
5. Sew corner units, star point units and A-center square together in rows; press toward corners and center. Sew rows together.

Make (1) Starz block that measures 6 1/2" square.
