$(X)=$ cut square twice diagonally to yeild 4 triangles
LIGHT - A - (1) 2 1/2" sq.

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Medium - C-(12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
DARK - D - (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ sq.

## Assembly

1. Layer (2) B-light triangles on opposite sides of each $C$-medium rectangle, right sides up, aligning top corners; glue in place.

Topstitch $1 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (12) Unit \#1.
2. Sew a Unit \#1 on opposite sides of center A-light square; press toward A. Add a dark $D$-square to each end of (2) Unit \#1; press toward D. Sew to top and

 bottom of center; press.
3. Stitch 4 sets of (2) Unit \#1 together. Sew a pair of Unit \#I's on opposite sides of center star; press toward center. Add a dark $D$-square to each end of remaining pairs of Unit \#1's; press toward D. sew to top and bottom of center; press.

Piece (1) Framed Star block that measures $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

By utilizing my layered patchwork technique, we've eliminated 24 seams for a FLATTER, SMOOTHER BLOCK.
