LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION BY KTQ, LYNNE HAGMEIER

KT LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION

(/)=cut square once diagonally to yeild 2 triangles

LIGHT - A - (4) 2 1/2" sq. (/)

MEDIUM - B - (1) 2 1/2" sq.

C - (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

DARK - D - (1) 2 1/2" sq. (X)

(only 2 triangles will be used)

E - (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

ASSEMBLY

1. Layer (2) D-dark triangles on opposite sides of the B-medium square, right sides up; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (1) Unit #1 center.

TIP: Topstitch across the center points in an "X", as shown, to keep points flat.

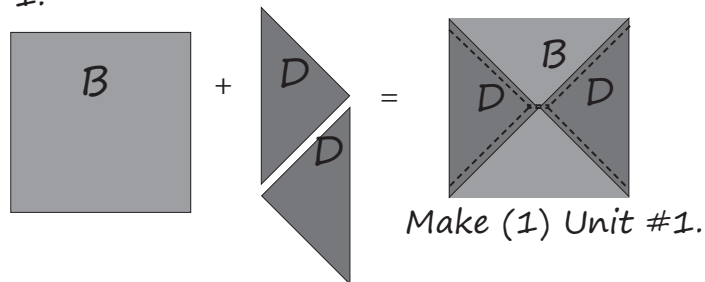
2. Layer (2) B-light triangles on opposite sides of each C-medium rectangle, right sides up, aligning top corners; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (2) Unit #2a.

3. Layer (2) B-light triangles on opposite sides of each E-dark rectangle, right sides up, aligning top corners; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (2) Unit #2b.

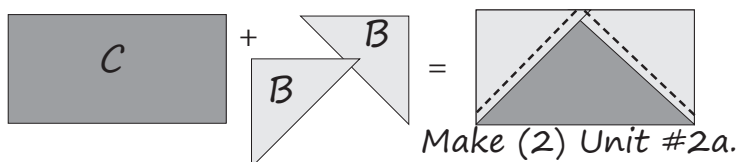
4. Stitch Unit #2a's and 2b's around center Unit #1. Begin by adding a Unit #2a to the top of the Unit #1 center, stopping about 1/2" from right side. Next, add a Unit #2b to the left side of the center. Continue adding units in a counter clockwise direction with steps 3 and 4. Finish by completing seam #1. Press away from center.

Piece (1) Turnstile block that measures 6 1/2" square.
