## **A**SSEMBLY

- 1. Layer a C-triangle on one side of each A-square, right sides up, aligning straight edges; glue in place. Topstitch '%" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread, as shown. Make (4) Unit #1.
- 2. Create half square triangles by placing D & B squares right sides together. Draw a line diagonally on wrong side of each D. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of drawn line; cut on drawn line. Press toward D. Trim D/B half square triangles to 2 1/2" square each. Make (4).
- 3. Layer an E-square <u>cut on the bias</u> on the B side of the D/B half square triangle; glue in place, aligning corners. Topstitch ½" from bias edges of B-square with coordinating cotton thread, as shown. Make (4) Unit #2.
- 4. Lay out center A-square, Unit #1's and Unit #2's in a 9-patch, as shown. Sew units together in rows; press toward Unit #1. Sew rows together; press. Make (1) Aunt Dinah block that measures 6 ½" square.
