LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION BY KTQ, LYNNE HAGMEIER

KT LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION

(/) = cut square once diagonally to yield 2 triangles

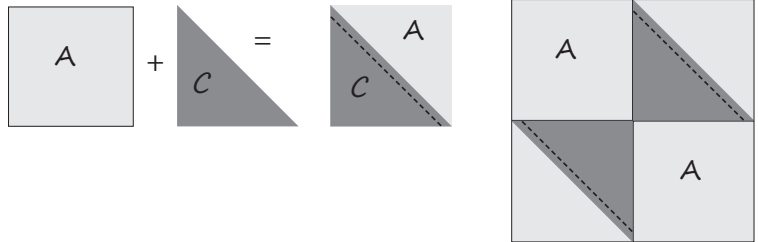
LIGHT #1 - A - (8) 1 1/4" sq.
B - (4) 1 1/4" x 2"

DARK #1 - C - (5) 1 1/4" sq. (/)

LIGHT #2 - D - (16) 1 1/4" sq.
E - (4) 2" x 3 1/2"

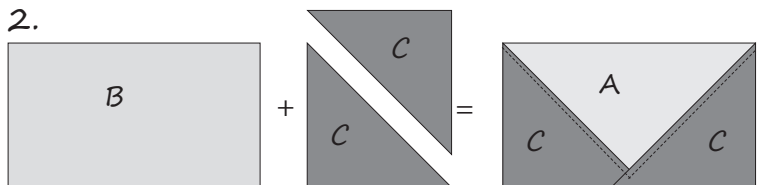
DARK #2 - F - (4) 1 1/4" sq. (/)
G - (4) 2" sq. (/)

Unit #1 - Make 1

Unit #2 - Make 4

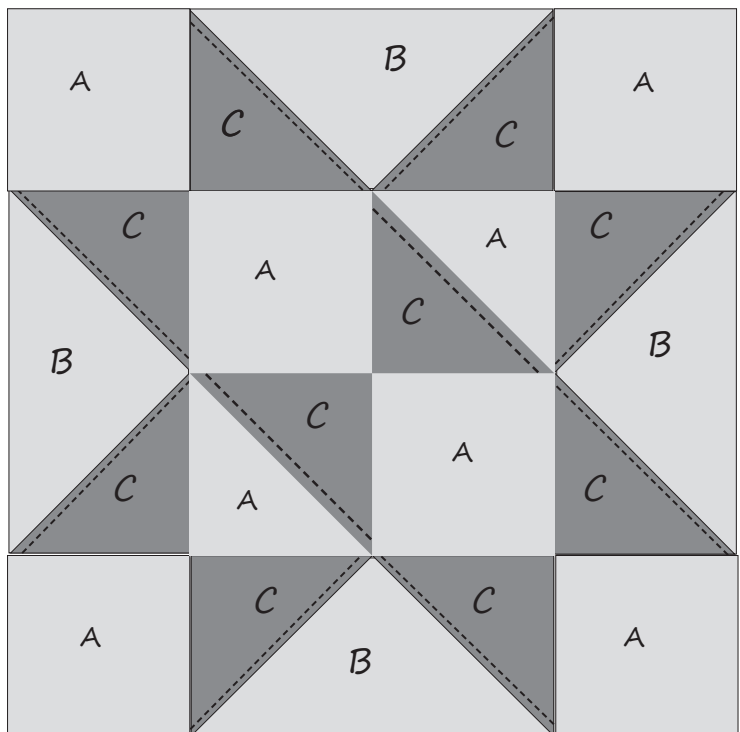
ASSEMBLY

1. Layer a C-triangle on one side of (2) A-squares, right sides up, aligning straight edges; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Layout (2) A-squares with (2) layered A/C half square triangles to make (1) Unit #1 that measures 2" square.

2. Create (4) star point units by placing a C-triangle on two corners of each B-rectangle, right sides up with corners aligning. Glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of C-triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make (4) B/C star points for Unit #2 that measure 1 1/4" x 2".

3. Lay out Unit #1 in the center with (4) Unit #2's and A-squares in the corners, as shown. Sew units together in rows; press toward center and corners. Sew rows together; press seams open. Make center star block that measures 3 1/2" square.

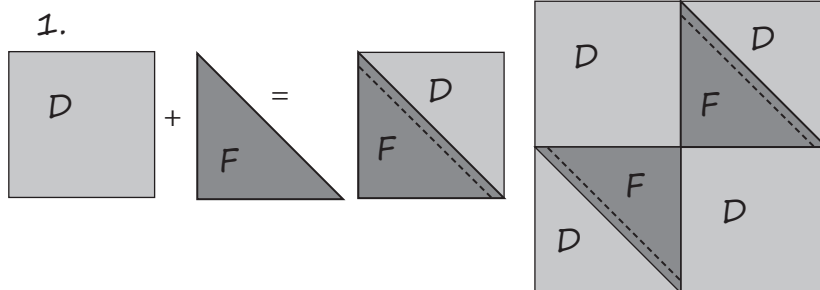

ASSEMBLY

3. Layer an F-triangle on one corner of (8) D-squares, right sides up, aligning corners; glue in place. Topstitch $\frac{1}{8}$ " from bias edges of triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Layout (2)

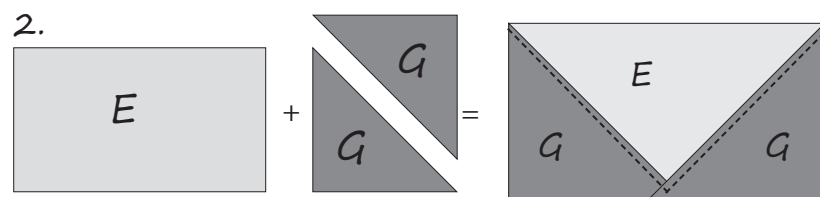
D-squares with (2) layered D/F half square triangles to make (4) Unit #3 that measure 2" square each.



Unit #3 - Make 4

2. Create star point units by placing a G-triangle on two corners of each E-rectangle, right sides up with corners aligning. Glue in place. Topstitch $\frac{1}{8}$ " from bias edges of G-triangles with coordinating cotton thread. Make

(4) E/G star points for Unit #4 that measure 2" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Unit #4 - Make 4

3. Lay out center star with Unit #3 in the corners and star point Unit #4's surrounding center, as shown. Sew units together in rows; press toward star point units. Sew rows together; press. Make (1) Coronation block that measures 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

My Layered Patchwork technique eliminated (24) seams for a flatter block.
