LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION BY KTQ, LYNNE HAGMEIER

KT LAYERED PATCHWORK OPTION

LIGHT - A - (4) 2 1/2" sq.

B - (4) 1 1/2" sq. (/)

DARK #1 - C - (8) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

D - (1) 2 1/2" sq.

DARK #2 - E - (4) 1 1/4" sq.*
cut on the bias

BROWN - F - (1) 2" circle

ASSEMBLY

1. Layer an E-square that has been cut on the bias (as shown) on a corner of each A-square, right sides up, aligning corners; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of square with coordinating cotton thread. Make (4) Unit #1.

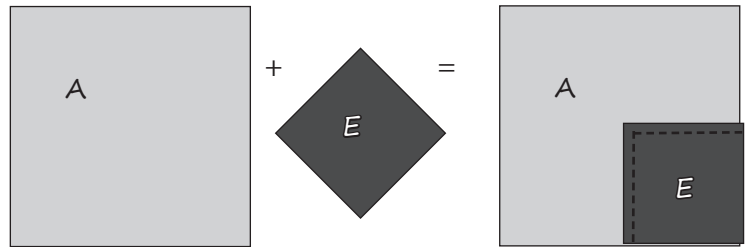
2. Layer a B-triangle on C-rectangle, right sides up with upper left corners aligning. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangle with tan cotton thread. Make (4) Unit #2.

3. Lay out Center D-square, Unit #1's and Unit #2's in a 9-patch. Sew units together in rows; press toward A's. Sew rows together; press.

4. Center F-gold circle on D-square; glue in place. Topstitch 1/8" from bias edges of triangle with gold cotton thread. Make (1) Sunflower block that measures 6 1/2" square.

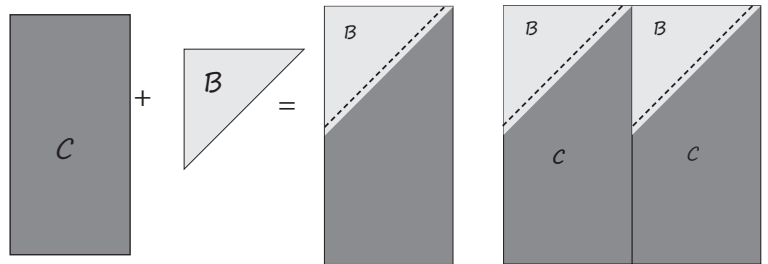
*Be sure to cut the E-squares on point so all exposed edges are on the bias for less raveling.
