Cutting: The first number is for the lap size or bed runner size, the number in parenthesis is for the table runner size. You will need 9 Cross and Crown blocks for the lap size, 5 for the Bed Runner, and 2 or 3 for the table runner depending on how you want to configure it.

From each red fabric:
1-3 1/2" ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip by WOF
Subcut: $2-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares
4-3" (2") squares
$5-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}\right)$ squares
From Background Fabric (cream) for each block:
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip by WOF
Subcut: $2-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares
4-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}\right)$ squares
4- $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ by $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ ( $1^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ by $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ ) rectangles

Instructions:
(All seams are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ )

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ background squares, and the $3^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ print squares.

2. Place marked background squares right side together with the Print squares that are the same size. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the marked line.

3. Cut apart on the marked line.

4. Press toward the print. And Square to $3^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

5. Place the marked print squares right sides together with the half square triangles creating an $X$ in the middle of the block as pictured.

6. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the marked line and cut apart on the line.

7. Press toward the print triangle. Square to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}\right)$.

8. Lay out your $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares and pieced squares in four patches for each corner. Then your rectangles and center square in a cross as pictured.

9. Sew your four corner 4 patches together.
10. Sew the three rows.

11. Then sew the three rows together. And you are done.
