

## QUILT-NON SAMPLER BLOCKS 3 & 4

Block 1 Old Maid's Puzzle:

Cutting:



5- 2 3/8" squares of dark fabric cut in half diagonally to create 10 triangles

3- 2 3/8" squares of bright or light fabric cut in half diagonally to create 6 triangles

1 - 3 7/8" square of medium or patterned fabric cut in half diagonally to create 2 triangles

4 - 2" squares of dark fabric

Create 4 units like this by sewing the long sides of a light triangle and a dark triangle together



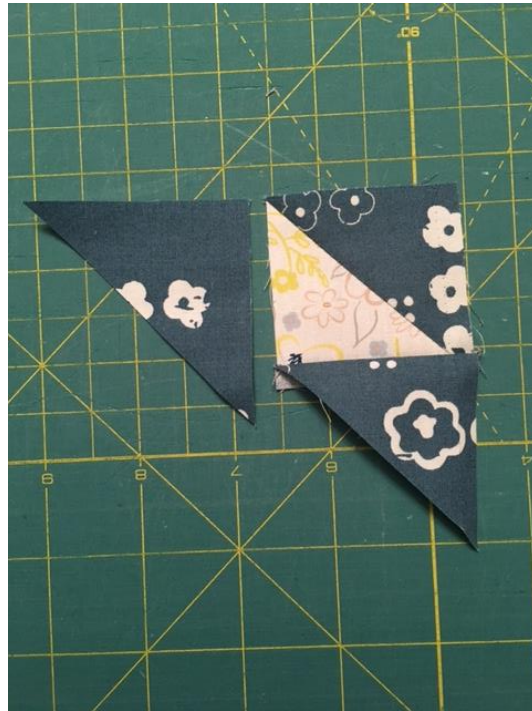
Create two 4 patch units like this from the 2" squares and the units from the previous step.



Sew the 90 degree corner of a dark triangle to the light side of one of the half square triangles (hst) as shown.



Repeat for the other side of the light half of the hst as shown.



Repeat to make a total of two units.

Sew the long side of the large print/medium tone triangles to these units



Sew the four complete units together like this.



Square to 6 ½"

## Block 2 Dutch Surprise

### Cutting:



2 – 2 3/8" squares of Dark fabric cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles

1 – 4 1/4" square of dark fabric cut diagonally twice to make 4 quarter square triangles

4 - 1 1/4" by 2 5/8" rectangles each of Light/bright, medium/print, and medium dark fabric

1 – 2 5/8" square of dark fabric or a fussy cut on point

Sew 4 units that are made up of the light/bright, medium/print, and medium dark rectangles as shown



Sew one of the quarter square triangles (made from the 4 ¼" square) to two opposite sides of the one of the units just created as shown. Sew two units like this. (if you mix up the triangles these will be the larger of the two sizes)



Make a crease in the long side of the half square triangles to mark the center. And do the same on the darker of the rectangle unit so that you can match the centers. Sew. And repeat to make two units.



Sew one three rectangle unit to each side of the dark/fussy cut square as shown.



Find the center of the two ends and match up the remaining half square triangles and sew them.



Sew the three rows together as shown.



Square to 6 1/2"
