

Commissioner Meeting  
November 28, 2016

Vice Chairman Ben Fox called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Cole Conard, Kathy Robison, County Clerk, and Paul Dean, County Counselor. Chairman Brian Hind joined the meeting via telephone at 9:15 a.m.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve November 21, 2016 minutes. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Roger Lowe, Road and Bridge Supervisor, reported they received a blade back that had been repaired, FEMA was here last week and will be back today; reported crews have been doing tree trimming; worked on a cattle guard at Bakers'; reported they were done retrieving gravel on J Rd. and P Rd.; reported they are working on a washout, hauling three loads of gravel today; waiting for Leiser to replace a couple of tin horns in the northern part of the county. Commissioner Conard asked Lowe if he had assigned someone to the Lamont Road that Commissioner Hind had asked him about. Lowe said that he had someone assigned to it. They discussed Christian Hills Bridge and the road.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve a payable in the amount of \$45.82. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion for a 5 minute executive session for personnel with Sheriff Heath Samuels. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion for a 5 minute executive session for legal with Levi Vinson, Noxious Weed Director and Paul Dean, County Counselor. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox made a motion for a 5 minute executive session for personnel with Paul Dean, County Counselor. Commissioner Conard seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Commissioner Fox wanted to clarify the clerk's minutes from last week's meeting in regards to the Brown property and easement issues. If the parties involved wish to re-open the road in question, they will have to pay for the road to be brought to current standards. At that point, it would be the township's responsibility to maintain the road. County Counselor Paul Dean added that to his knowledge, none of the parties was interested in bringing the road back up to standards.

The commissioners discussed having a year-end dinner for the county employees and approved it. It will be held, December 30<sup>th</sup>, they decided to request the same meal as last year and bids will be requested from area caterers for the meal.

Commissioner Conard made a motion to approve \$50 year-end gifts for full time employees and \$25 for part time, including active firemen. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.




At 9:40a.m. Commissioner Conard made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Fox seconded the motion. The motion carried.


