- *Fabric 1 ~ 1/2 yard
- *Fabric 2 ~ 1/2 yard
- 1 ~ 9" zipper (small wallet)
- 1 ~ 12" zipper (large wallet)
- 80/12 Embroidery Needle
- Poly-mesh Stabilizer*
- 1 ~ size 20 kamsnap (I have a lot of colors)
- Cotton batting

Small Wallet:

- 1 ~ 6" x 8" (**A**)
- 1 ~ 7 1/2" x 11 1/2" (**D**)
- 1 ~ 7 1/2" x 4 1/2" (**M**)

Large Wallet:

- 1 ~ 8" x 14" (**J**)

Shape-flex

- 1 ~ 8" x 4"

505 Spray

Mega Hoop, Maxi Hoop, or Jumbo Hoop

Large Wallet:

Fabric 1

B ~ 8"w x 5"h

E ~ 8"w x 5 1/2"h

Small Wallet

F ~ 8"w x 8"h This is the checkbook pocket. Fold this piece in half wrong sides together to measure 8" x 4" and press. Place the shape-flex inside of the folded checkbook pocket piece and fuse it inside the piece. This is to add strength to the pocket.

H ~ 8"w x 5½"h

I ~ 8"w x 14"h

Fabric 2

A ~ 8"w x 5"h

C & D ~ 8"w x 7"h (cut 2) These are the credit card pockets. Fold each of these pieces in half wrong sides together to measure 8" x 3.50" and press.

G ~ 8"w x 5½"h

Small Wallet:

B & C ~ 6"w x 8"h (cut 2)

Quilted Outside of Wallet:

Fabric 1

E ~ 7½"w x 11½"h

Wallet:

Fabric 1

F ~ 7½"w x 6"h

I ~ 7½"w x 2½½h Fold the bottom long edge of this piece under ½". Be sure to measure. After folding under, press. A photo is below in the instructions of this piece.

L ~ 7½"w x 5"h

Fabric 2:

G & H ~ 7½"w x 7"h (cut 2) Fold both pieces wrong sides together to measure 7½"w x 3½"h

J & K ~ 7½"w x 5"h
