Instructions: Trace entire owl outline on a piece of paper. Use that as your template to cut out the owl on a piece of black wool. Now you can move forward and create the front owl on that piece. Using your favorite wool appliqué method, cut out each wool piece and position in place. Use coordinating floss to blanket stitch around each piece securing them in place. Be sure to sew the front and back together either as you stitch the pieces or after you have stitched all the inner pieces of the owl. Sew 2 tiny black buttons on eyes for pupils. Use orange floss to stitch 2 X's on each ear. Use floss to make a hanger to hang ornament! Buttons and kits are available on our site! Enjoy!
