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Cutting Directions



Fabric #1 Cream/beige/white prints

Cut Print 1

- 6 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"2 are for HST



Fabric #2 Red Prints

Cut Print 1

- 2 squares 6" x 6"

Print 2

- 2 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for HST **Print 3**

- 4 strips 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Fabric #3 Aqua Prints Cut Print 1

- 1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Fabric #4 Gray Prints

Cut Print 1

- 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

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
Half Square Triangles Tutorial

NOTE- For other ways to make HST units, see my book "Pat Sloan's Teach Me to Sew Triangles"





- Using the red and cream 3.5" squares, Make 4 Half Square Triangle (HST) units



Step 1

of all the light squares



Step 2

- Draw a line on the back - Layer the dark and light square - Sew a 1/4" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step 3 Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



-Trim squares to 3" x 3" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam. Make 4 HST

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Corner Unit








- 1) Cut the remaining 4 cream squares In half on the diagonal
- You will have 8 triangles
- 2) Cut the red 6" squares in half on the diagonal


You will have 4 triangles






- 1) Following the diagram, Sew triangle 1 Lining up the top edge
- 2) Sew Triangle 2
- 3) Make 4








Step 3 Directions

- 1) Crease the large triangle to aid in placement
- 2) Line up the crease with the point
- 3) Sew the red Triangle to the HST unit
- Make 4

Trim unit to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Place the square ruler on the diagonal seam

To trim, just like you do for a HST



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



Assemble

Directions

- 1) Sew the red strip to the gray square
- 2) Make 4

Make 4 units that measure 2 1/2" x 5 1/2"





Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the quilt


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Unit size Assembly Diagram




Trim Block to 12.5" x 12.5" Finished Size 12" in the guilt
