Tiffany Hayes - Needle in a Hayes Stack



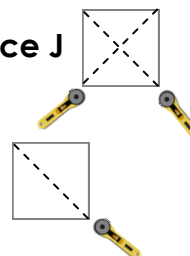
## Fabric Requirements:

- White -  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard
- Red -  $\frac{1}{3}$  yard
- Blue -  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard
- Black - fat eighth (9" x 22")
- Orange - (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4"
- Dark Orange - (4) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Green - (2) 6" x 8"
- Dark Green - (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10"

## Cutting Instructions:

### White:

- Cut 1 - 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x Width of Fabric (WOF)
- Sub-cut into 2 - 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally, twice, **Piece J**
- Sub-cut into 2 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece H**
- Sub-cut into 16 - 1  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 1  $\frac{7}{8}$ ", cut in half diagonally, **Piece G**
- Cut 4 - 2" x WOF
- Sub-cut into 4 - 2" x 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece A**
- Sub-cut into 8 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece I**

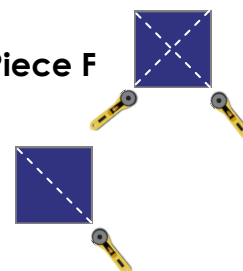


### Red:

- Cut 3 - 2" x WOF
- Sub-cut into 3 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece B**
- Cut 2 - 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF
- Sub-cut into 2 - 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece H**

### Blue:

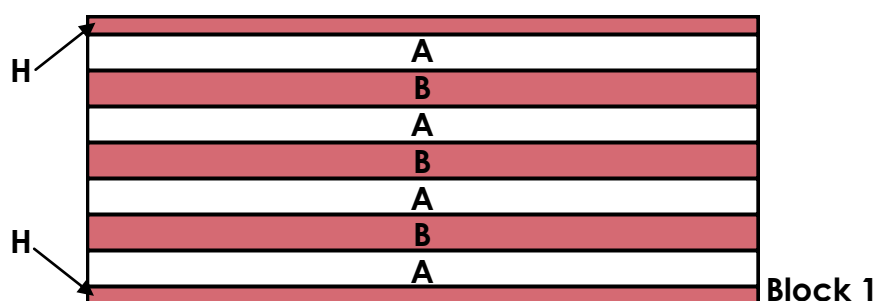
- Cut 1 - 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF
- Sub-cut into 4 - 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally, twice, **Piece F**
- Sub-cut into 4 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece D**
- Sub-cut into 8 - 1  $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 1  $\frac{7}{8}$ ", cut in half diagonally, **Piece K**
- Cut 1 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF
- Sub-cut into 16 - 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", **Piece E**



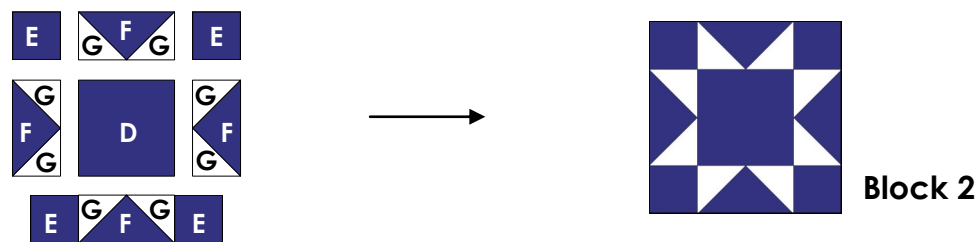

## Assembly:

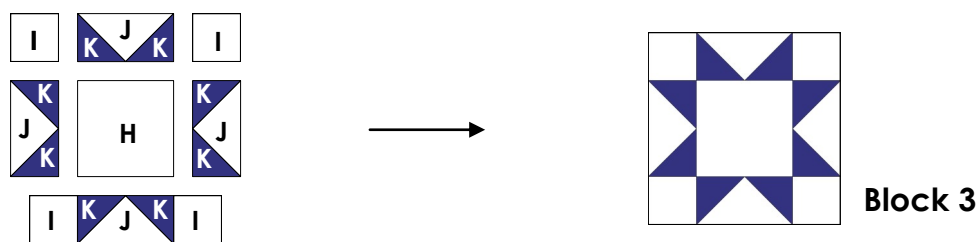
Combine 4 of **Piece A**, 3 of **Piece B** and 2 of **Piece H** to make **Block 1** as shown below. **Block 1** should measure 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



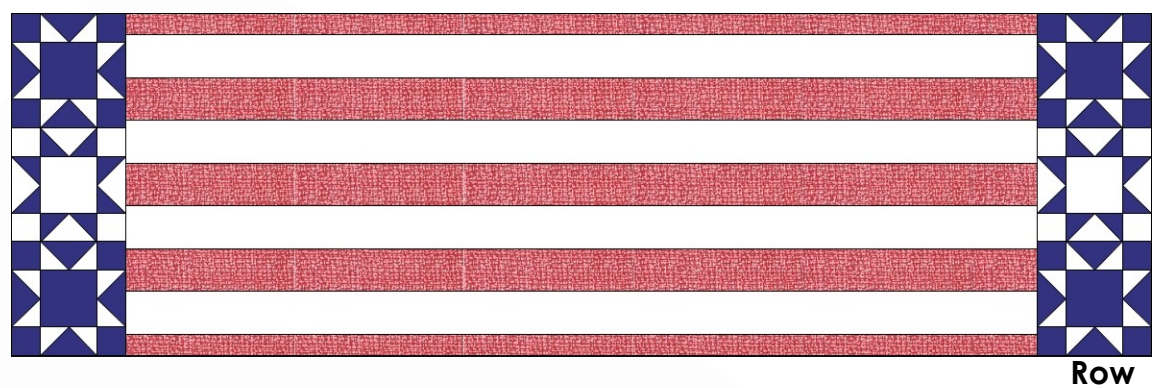
Combine 1 of **Piece D**, 4 of **Piece E**, 4 of **Piece F** and 8 of **Piece G** to make **Block 2** as shown below. Make 4 of **Block 2**. **Block 2** should measure 4 ½" x 4 ½".



Combine 1 of **Piece H**, 4 of **Piece I**, 4 of **Piece J** and 8 of **Piece K** to make **Block 3** as shown below. Make 2 of **Block 3**. **Block 3** should measure 4 ½" x 4 ½".



Combine 1 of **Block 1**, 4 of **Block 2** and 2 of **Block 3** to make the **Row** as shown below. **Row** should measure 12 ½" x 40 ½".



### The B2 Bomber

The Northrop (later Northrop Grumman) B-2 Spirit, also known as the Stealth Bomber, is an American heavy penetration strategic bomber, featuring low observable stealth technology designed for penetrating dense anti-aircraft defenses. It is a flying wing design with a crew of two. The B-2 is the only acknowledged aircraft that can carry large air-to-surface standoff weapons in a stealth configuration. The B-2 was first publicly displayed on 22 November 1988 at United States Air Force Plant 42 in Palmdale, California, where it was assembled. This viewing was heavily restricted and guests were not allowed to see the rear of the B-2. The B-2's first public flight was on 17 July 1989 from Palmdale to Edwards AFB.

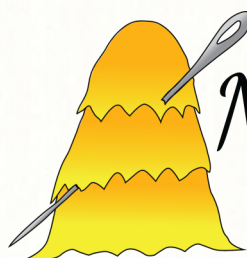
