We begin with an introduction to the safety, care and basic use of the sewing machine. Projects completed during camp will be Beginner Level projects. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

BASIC SEWING - Beginner Level. Learn the basics in four lessons! You will learn the parts of your machine and standard sewing techniques, then apply those techniques as you make simple beginner projects. Four three-hour sessions. **CLASS FEE \$50.**

BASICS OF EMBROIDERY – All Levels. CLASS FEE \$25 per session or FREE if you purchased your machine from us.

Session I: The Operation of Your Embroidery Machine When you purchase your machine we will schedule a private session with you to teach you how to operate your embroidery machine.

Session II: The Basics This class will be a lecture/demo about the basic supplies used for successful embroidery. We will include the selection of needles, threads, stabilizers and specialty notions designed to help you get started.

Session III: Successful Hooping and Design Placement Professional embroidery requires a knowledge of how to hoop and proper placement of your design.

CHIFFON FLOAT - Make this easy wardrobe accessory in a jiffy using your serger or sewing machine. One size fits most and can be made out of 1 1/8 yd of chiffon fabric. We will make a basic top and give pattern alteration ideas for other styles. This top is great over t-shirts and tank tops for a more modest outfit as well as comfort going from hot weather outside to air conditioning inside. Can also be used as a swim suit cover-up. You will want several of these for your summer wardrobe. **CLASS FEE: \$15. KIT FEE: \$12 Includes fabric and pattern.**

DUAL PURPOSE SEWING MAT - Learn some basic sewing skills while you make a sewing machine cover that will double as an organizer mat while you are using your machine. This project is an adaptation of the cover/mat we made with our students in Kids Camp this year. Check out our pictures of Kids Camp on our Facebook page to see the finished results. You will learn binding, sewing on buttons, boxing bag bottoms as well as other basic stitching. **CLASS FEE: \$15 KIT FEE: \$25 Includes Pattern**

HOOCHIE MAMMA BAG – This is a fun bag to make and also lots of fun to use. You might even think it is a bit “over the top” but lets think about the techniques you will learn. We begin with a sew and flip crazy patchwork technique, then embellish with bobbin work, decorative stitching and couching. Then come the beads and finally the compliments. Bring your own assortment of fabrics or ask us to order a kit for you to purchase. **CLASS FEE \$30.**

JUST BLOCKS- Beginner. Once you have learned the basics of making a quilt, you are ready to investigate various types of pieced blocks. Every quilt consists of a series of blocks. These blocks can be plain pieces of fabric, but most consist of piecing fabric together into a pattern. Each month we will make a new and different block. You will learn about the tips and unique challenges the different blocks present. **CLASS FEE: \$15 + \$8 KIT FEE**

KIDS SEWING CAMP - This has become one of our most popular December event. Give the gift of sewing to the next generation. For 4 days between Christmas and New Years Day, we will host a Sewing Camp for kids ages 7-12. We will teach the basics of sewing machine operation, safety features of using sewing equipment as we create one or two basic sewing projects. Our plans this year are to create a handy scrap bag and pin cushion combination and possibly a pair of slippers if time allows. **CLASS FEE: \$75 includes most supplies and daily snack.**

MACHINE MASTERY – All Levels. Bring your machine, instruction book and all accessories to this class and learn how to use your machine and its attachments. 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QUILT FINISH CLINIC - Gather up your unfinished quilt tops and join us for this FREE clinic. We will instruct you on how to complete these UFO's (unfinished quilts). We will discuss batting and backings and how to prepare your quilt sandwich to be quilted. Then you will schedule an appointment to bring the prepared quilt back in to the store and we will show you how to quilt your quilt on our NEW Juki Sit Down Quilting Machine. Once we get you started you can stay as long as it takes you to finish your quilt or until we close for the day. (in which case you may come back the following day to complete your quilt). Use of our machine is FREE with purchase of your supplies at All About Sewing. Supplies would include: backing, batting and thread.

SERGER MASTERY - Bring your serger and a basic sewing kit, and 4 different colors of serger thread to this class and learn how to thread and maintain your machine. We will also learn to adjust tensions to achieve a perfect balanced stitch and to convert your machine to do a rolled hem. FREE if you purchased your machine from us. One three-hour session. **CLASS FEE \$50.**

SILHOUETTE MASTERY - If you purchased your Cameo Silhouette at All About Sewing we invite you to join us for this new FREE training class. Tips on how to use Adhesive Vinyl, Heat Transfer Vinyl and how to use the Silhouette software to create your designs will be the focus of this class along with valuable tips to be successful with your Cameo cutting machine.
