$3 / 4$ yard ( $1 / 2$ yard)
$7 / 8$ yard ( $5 / 8$ yard)

$1 / 2$ yard ( $1 / 3$ yard)
$5 / 8$ yard (1/2 yard)


## You will also need:

- $11 / 8$ yards of fabric for the backing
- 38" x 38" piece of batting
- GO! Qube Mix \& Match 6" Block Set (55775)
- GO! Big Snail's Trail 12" Finished (55460)
- Basic Sewing Supplies \& Tools

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurement on borders are approximate. Measure your quilt top before cutting. Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance unless otherwise noted. Width of Fabric = WOF, Length of Fabric = LOF
Note: Below we have provided both die-cutting and traditional cutting instructions. You only need to use one set of cutting instructions in order to complete the project. The chosen method is up to you.

## Die Cutting Instructions:

## Red Bunting (A)

- Cut one $12^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into two $12^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Use GO! Big Snail's Trail $12^{\prime \prime}$ Finished die to cut two x-large triangles, two large triangles, two medium triangles, two small triangles and two squares.
- Cut two $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into eight $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Use GO! Qube Die \#4 to die-cut thirty-two small border triangles.


## Navy Fireworks (B)

-Cut one $12^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into two $12^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Use GO! Big Snail's Trail $12^{\prime \prime}$ Finished die to cut two $x$-large triangles, two large triangles, two medium triangles, two small triangles and two squares.

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Use GO! Qube Die \#1 to die-cut four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- Cut two $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into eight $51 / 2 "$ squares. Use GO! Qube Die \#4 to die-cut thirty-two small border triangles.


## Red Fireworks (C)

- Cut one $12^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into two $12^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Use GO! Big Snail's Trail $12^{\prime \prime}$ Finished die to cut two $x$-large triangles, two large triangles, two medium triangles, two small triangles and two squares.
- Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## Navy Large Stars (D)

- Cut one $12^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut into two 12"x 14" rectangles. Use GO! Big Snail's Trail 12 " Finished die to cut two x-large triangles, two large triangles, two medium triangles, two small triangles and two squares.


## White Small Stars (E)

- Cut three $51 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into sixteen $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Use GO! Qube Die \#5 to die-cut thirty-two large border triangles.


## Backing (Your Choice)

- Cut $38^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ square for the backing.


## Traditional Cutting Instructions: <br> Red Bunting (A)

- Cut one $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut two $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $37 / s^{\prime \prime}$ squares and two 3 " squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make four x-large triangles, large triangles, medium triangles and small triangles.
- Cut one 2"x WOF strip. Sub-cut into four 2" squares.
- Cut one $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into eight $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make thirty-two small border triangles.


## Navy Fireworks (B)

- Cut one $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut two $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and two 3 " squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make four $x$-large triangles, large triangles, medium triangles and small triangles.
- Cut one 2"x WOF strip. Sub-cut into four 2" squares.
- Cut one $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into eight $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make thirty-two small border triangles.
- Cut one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut into four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


## Red Fireworks (C)

- Cut one $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut two $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and two $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make four x-large triangles, large triangles, medium triangles and small triangles.
- Cut one 2"x WOF strip. Sub-cut into four 2 " squares.
- Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## Navy Large Stars (D)

- Cut one $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut two $67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, two $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and two 3 " squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make four x-large triangles, large triangles, medium triangles and small triangles.
- Cut one 2"x WOF strip. Sub-cut into four 2" squares.


## White Small Stars (E)

- Cut three $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into sixteen $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make thirty-two large border triangles.


## Backing (Your Choice)

- Cut 38 " $\times 38$ " square for the backing.


## Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew together two $2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares and two 2 "Fabric $B$ squares to make one 4 -patch unit (Fig. 1).
2. Rotate the 4 -patch unit on point so the Fabric $A$ square is at the top. Sew one small Fabric $D$ triangle to the upper left and lower right side the 4-patch square. Sew one small Fabric C triangle to the upper right and lower left side of the 4-patch to make the center unit (Fig. 2).
3. Rotate the center unit on point so the Fabric $C$ triangle is at the top. Sew one medium Fabric $B$ triangle to the upper left and lower right side the center unit. Sew one medium Fabric A triangle to the upper right and lower left side of the center unit (Fig. 3).
4. Rotate the center unit on point so the Fabric $B$ triangle is at the top. Sew one large Fabric $C$ triangle to the upper left and lower right side the center unit. Sew one large Fabric D triangle to the upper right and lower left side of the center unit (Fig. 4).

5. Rotate the center unit on point so the Fabric $D$ triangle is at the top. Sew one $x$-large Fabric $A$ triangle to the upper left and lower right side the center unit. Sew one x-large Fabric B triangle to the upper right and lower left side of the center unit to complete Block One square (Fig. 5).
6. Repeat Steps $1-5$ to make a second Block One square.

7. Follow Figure 6 for fabric placement and repeat Steps 1-5 to make Two Block Two squares.

8. Sew together one small Fabric $A$ Border triangle, one small Fabric $B$ border triangle and one large Fabric E border triangle to make one Unit 1 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make sixteen Unit 1 squares total.
9. Sew together one small Fabric A Border triangle, one small Fabric B border triangle and one large Fabric E border triangle to make one Unit 2 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make sixteen Unit 2 squares total.
10. Sew together one Unit 1 square and one Unit 2 square to make one Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make sixteen Unit 3 rectangles total.

## Quilt Top Assembly Instructions: Refer to Quilt Layout while assembling.

11. Sew together two Block One squares and two Block Two squares to make the quilt top.
12. 

Sew together four Unit 3 rectangles, end-to-end to make one side border. Repeat to make the second side border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
13.

Sew together four Unit 3 rectangles and two $31 / 2$ "Fabric B squares to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
14. ${ }^{\text {Layer and quilt as desired. }}$
15.

Sew the four $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x LOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16.

Bind as desired.
