
Keep in mind that while we are doing our Head Start Quilts we still need to be aware that we need to do our quilts for the Honor Flight coming in September.

The pattern is an original by Judy Hansen, owner of Quilt Shop of Deland. The floors in the Stetson Mansion are parquet and each room has a different design. Judy has used several floor patterns as inspiration for her designs. Linda Spence (Fat Cat Quilter) did the long arm quilting. I chose the pattern because I was trying to use up fabrics in my stash that were of limited quantity.



Barb Rule-Mispel did this Jenny Dorn pattern from one of her teaching videos but made it a little bigger. They are 2-1/2 strips and has shared this.....when using something with writing in it, ie, love, hope etc, make sure you check to see that it is going in the right direction before putting it all together. Quilt of the week for June 21, 2016


