### **Piccadilly Circus Supply List**

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This quilt is a large version of a Dresden Plate pattern, the blocks finish at 25", a nice way to get a large quilt by making only 9 blocks! You may use 2 jelly rolls like the pattern suggests, or do as I did and use (18) ½ yard cuts of 9 colors. I happened to have collected these fabrics and decided this was the perfect pattern to use them.

### **Supplies**

**Pattern: Piccadilly Circus by Thimble Blossoms**

**Fabric:**

- 2 Jelly rolls or (72) 2 ½" X WOF strips (\*Please cut these prior to class!)
- 3 ¾ yards of darker background fabric
- 3 yards of lighter background fabric
- ½ yard for Dresden centers
- ¾ yard for Binding
- 4 ½ yards for Backing
- 1 ½ yards of fusible web (Dresden Centers)

### **Additional Supplies and Materials**

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Sewing machine needles (I recommend Microtex 80/12 or Jeans 80/12)
- 100% Cotton thread
- Filled bobbins
- Rotary cutter and mat (you may use the shop mats in class)
- 6" X 12" and 6" X 12" rulers
- 2 sheets of heavy duty template plastic; OR, 1 sheet of template plastic for the centers and the **CGRSG1 Ruler** from Creative Grids for the wedges
- Thread clippers
- Seam ripper
- Fine, straight pins
