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About Deirdre Bond Abel



Deirdre Bond Abel has been a quilter for about thirty years, and is passionate about sharing her love of the craft.

She started her quilting journey in Ashmore, Queensland making a traditional sampler quilt. A number of classes later she picked up Mary Tendall and Connie Tesene's self-titled book "Country Threads", and her life was changed forever. The quilts in the book combined piecing and applique in rich warm colours and she was hooked straight away. The book also featured the business "Country Thread", run by these two wonderful ladies on Mary's farm. Deirdre was excited at the thought of having quilts and animals as the focus of a business!

Several years into her quilting journey the family moved to the country town of Warwick, Queensland where she started teaching classes of her own designs at a local quilt store.

The family then moved to Tasmania and bought a beautiful little farm, which they called Hat Creek. At the time she thought how wonderful it would be to have a shop and teach classes at the farm just like Country Threads, however educating children and needing "a real job" put this dream to the back of her mind.

A little over ten years ago she became one half of The Quilted Crow, a patchwork store in Hobart, Tasmania. The Quilted Crow Girls had great success, including having two books published by Martingale (who published that Country Threads book all those years ago) as well as designing a cotton fabric line and selecting colours for a wool fabric line for Marcus Fabrics. The girls travelled the world and Deirdre got to meet her two idols Mary and Connie at their iconic shop/farm in Garner, Iowa.

At the end of 2014 The Quilted Crow Girls went their separate ways and this led Deirdre back to her original dream of offering shopping and classes on the family farm, and so Hat Creek Quilts was born.

Deirdre's passions (apart from her family and Harry the dog) are traditional quilts, reproduction cotton prints from the 19th and early 20th Centuries and washed woven wool. You will see these passions and her gift for colour selection reflected in her many stunning designs including quilts, table runners and wall hangings.
