

Four and Twenty Blackbirds



Supply List:

Dark gold solid background fabric
—12-1/2" square.

Black wool—5" X 10"

Black plaid wool—1" X 2"

Tan plaid wool—4" X 11"

Red wool—1" X 2"

Cheddar wool—2" X 2"

#12 pearl cotton—black and brown

#8 pearl cotton—black and beige

Embroidery floss—red and cheddar

Instructions:

Cut a 12-1/2" square piece of background fabric. Using the layout guide, center design on fabric. Transfer lettering to fabric. Fuse, glue or pin wool to fabric. Applique wool in the following order:

G with #12 black pearl cotton using a blanket stitch.

F with #12 brown pearl cotton using a blanket stitch. Embroider pie crust line with #12 brown pearl cotton using a stem stitch.

J with 1 strand of red embroidery floss using a blanket stitch.

H and I with 1 strand of cheddar embroidery floss using a slip stitch.

A, B, C, D and E with #12 black pearl cotton using a blanket stitch.

K, L, M and N with 1 strand of cheddar embroidery floss using a slip stitch.

Embroider lettering with #8 black pearl cotton using a back stitch.

Eyes are French knots with #8 beige pearl cotton.

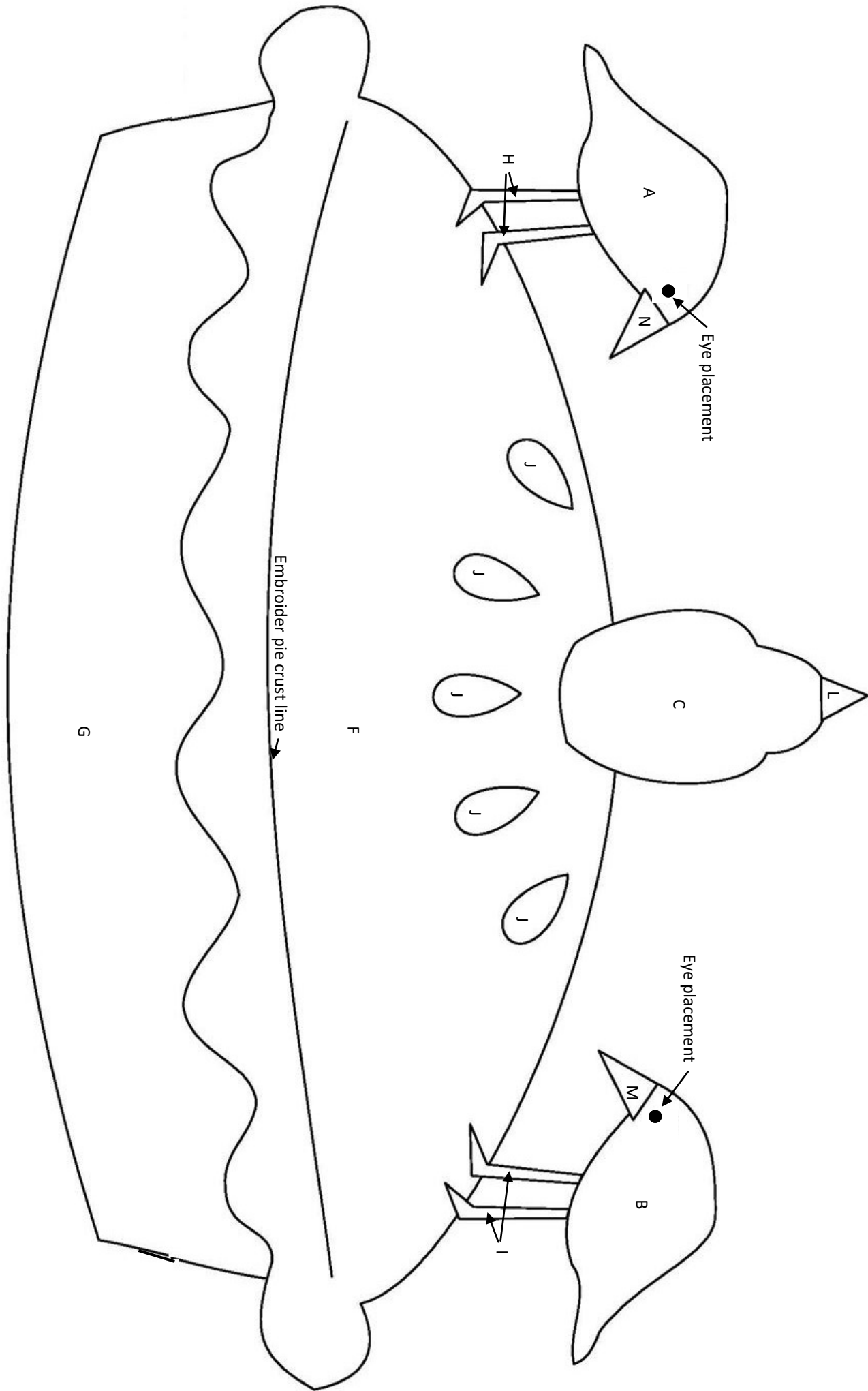
