## Summer Blog Hop—Block 1

### Supply List:

14" square light tan print  
fabric, cut in half diagonally



14" square green plaid  
fabric, cut in half diagonally



Black wool—2" X 3"

Green wool—2" X 3"

Brown wool—3" X 3"

Red wool—1" X 3-1/2"

Blue wool—1" X 1-1/2"

Barn red wool—6" X 7"

Off white wool—4" X 5"

Valdani #12 pearl cotton or #15 wool  
thread in colors to match wool.

### Instructions:

Cut wool following the instructions on Page 2

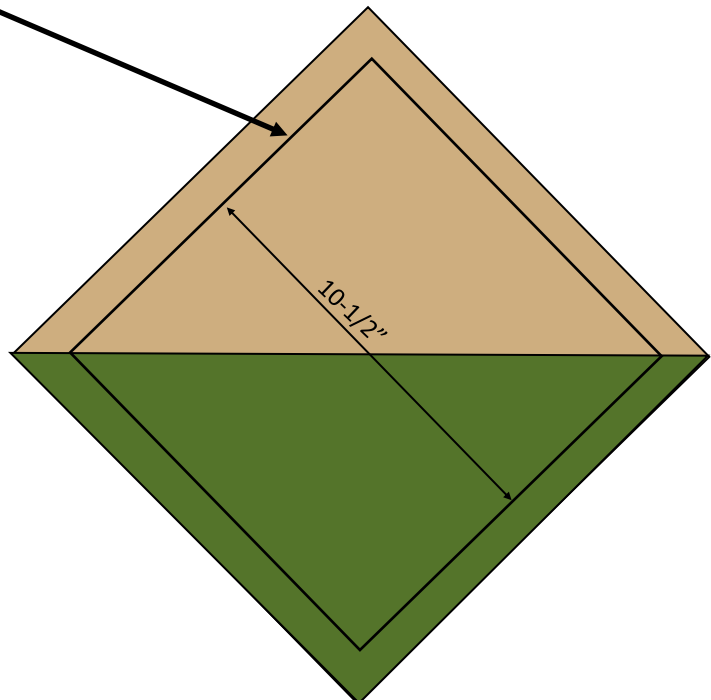
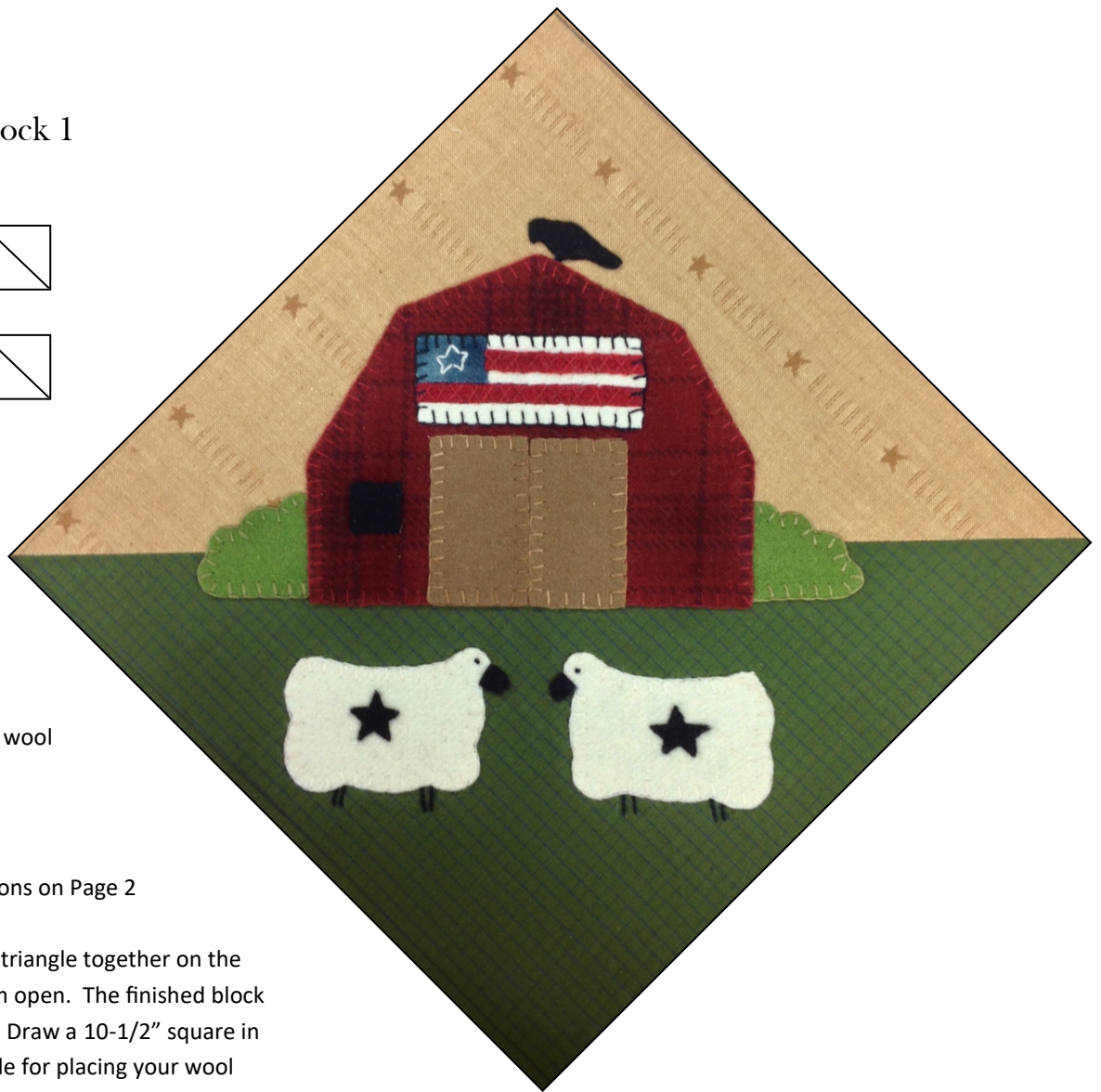
Sew a tan print and green plaid triangle together on the long edge as shown. Press seam open. The finished block is larger than you need it to be. Draw a 10-1/2" square in the center of the block as a guide for placing your wool (keep in mind this includes a 1/4" seam allowance).

Fuse or pin wool to block using the picture above for placement. Hand stitch wool with matching thread using your favorite method. I use a blanket stitch, except for the flag where I did red cross stitches on the red stripes. The blue section is blanket stitched on the inner edges with blue thread. I outlined the flag with a blanket stitch in black. Straight stitch the star on the flag with off white thread.

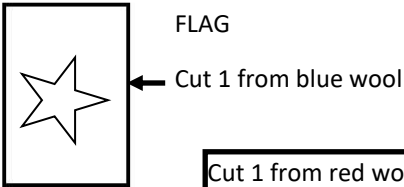
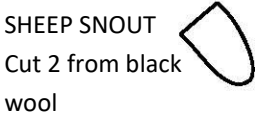
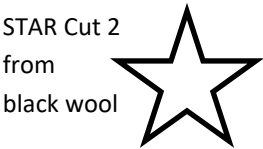
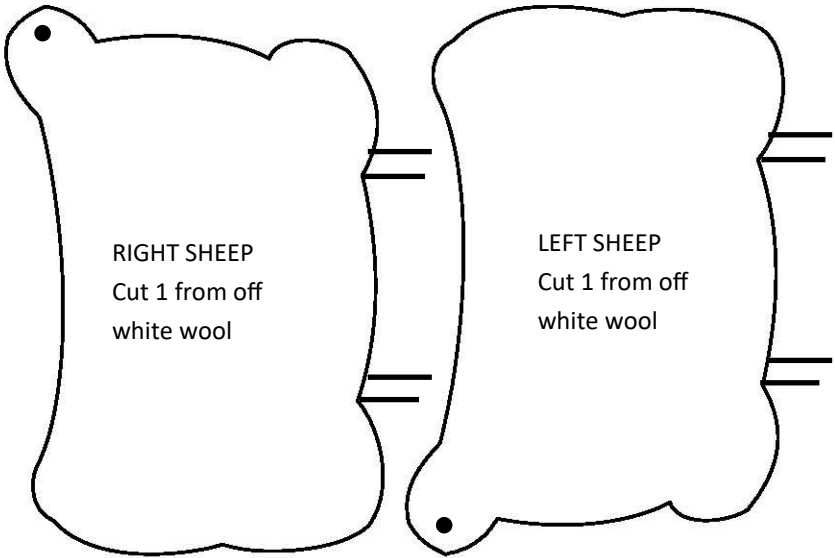
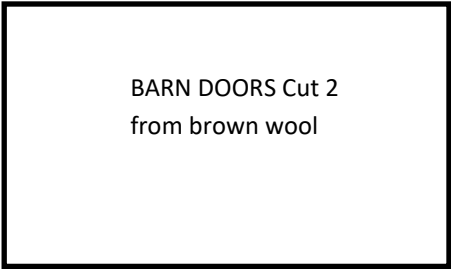
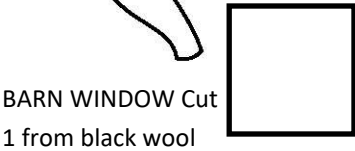
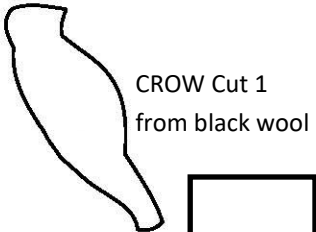
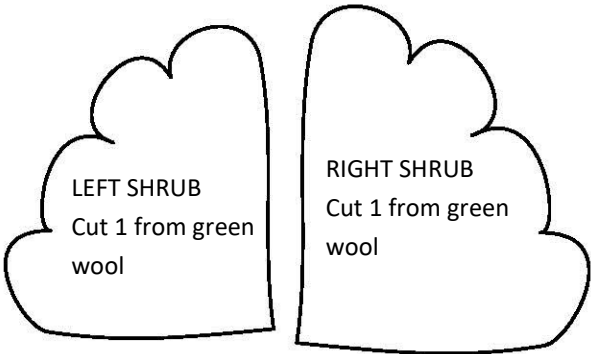
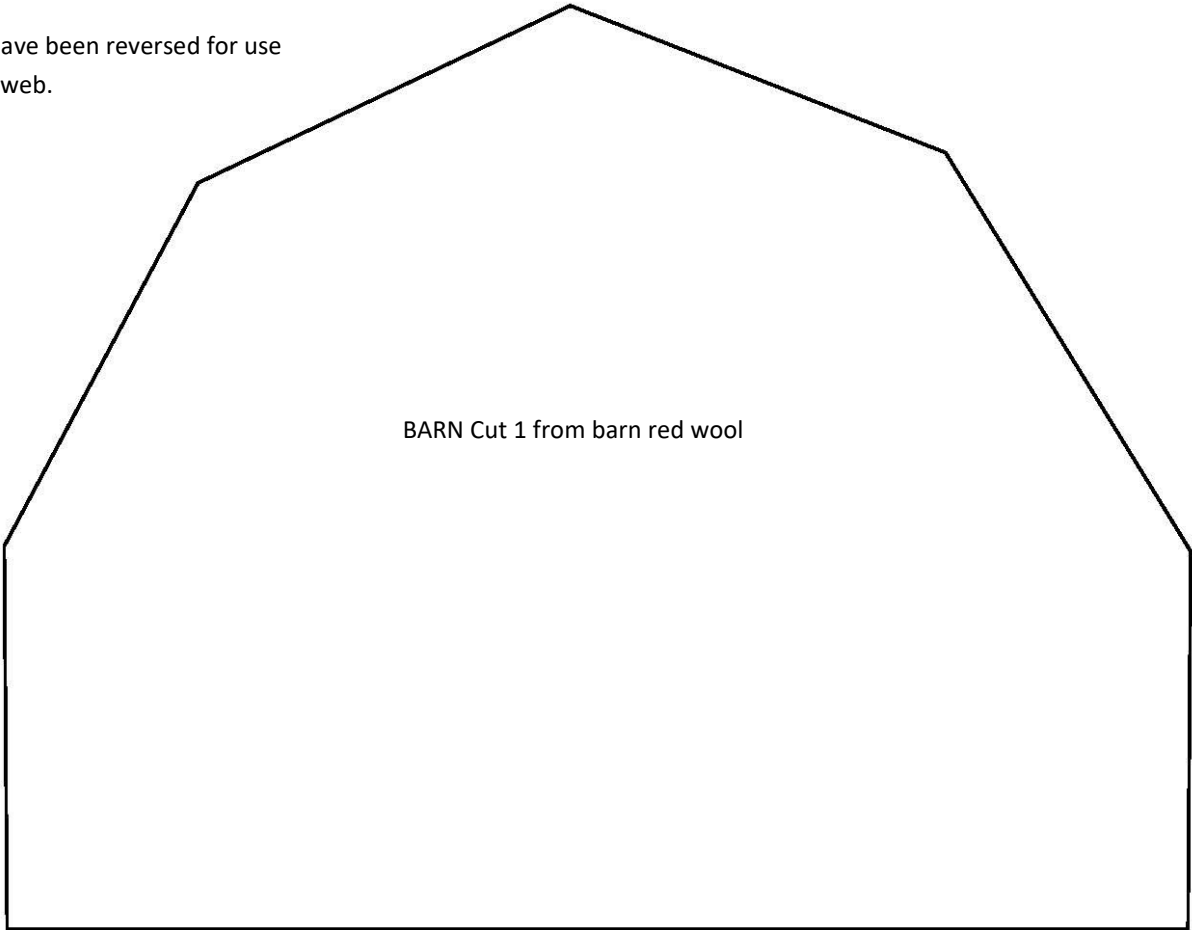
Back stitch the crow and sheep feet. The sheep eyes are a black French knot. Trim your block down to 10-1/2" square.
