ways to spice up their gardens. We buy flowering plants with brightly-colored blooms; trendy tropicals with exotic flowers; or plant new containers to brighten up insipid spots in the border. And while these are all reasonable ways to add appeal. there is an easier longer-lasting way - choose plants with Chameleon Plant (Houttuynia variegated foliage.

Variegation is the appearance of differently-colored marks, patches, or streaks in leaves and is caused by pigments in plant cells. Leaves can be variegated in a myriad of colors, and variegation can be sharply defined or softly blended.

Leaf edges, centers or veins on plants as small as groundcovers White Nancy, and Pink Pewter (Caryopteris). Summer Sorbet or as large as trees and shrubs offer valued variegated foliage for the landscape. No hostas appear below - they deserve an article all to themselves.

## Groundcovers

Burgundy Glow Carpet Bugle (Ajuga reptans) is a dense, short, mat-like groundcover that presents pink, white and green leaves. Plant it beneath a purplefoliaged shrub for a pleasing

cordata) has beautiful, heartshaped leaves of red, cream and deep green. It may only grow 8 to 10" tall, but this is a fastgrowing groundcover that can Plant it in become invasive. containers or in areas where it has plenty of room to spread.

Liven up shade gardens with (Lamium Spotted Deadnettle Beacon Silver, maculatum). each have silvery-white leaves with green margins and bloom in deep pink, bright pink, or white. Anne Greenaway has blended dark green, pale green, chartreuse and silver foliage.



## **Perennials**

Best planted in a sunny rock garden or between stepping stones the cream and white grass -like, evergreen foliage of Nifty Thrifty Common Thrift (Armeria maritima) dazzles in the sunshine. Its pink flowers in May and June are a bonus.

Choose either Jack Frost or Looking Glass Heartleaf (Brunnera Brunnera macrophylla) to brighten up a shady border. Clouds of blue forget-me-not flowers bloom for six weeks or longer in spring over 12 to 15" tall mounds of large, heart-shaped, richly-textured, frosty silver foliage. Plant either beside Japanese painted ferns for a match made in heaven.

For the middle of a sunny border, choose Bluebeard has periwinkle blue flower clusters in August over bright yellow-margined green foliage. Snow Fairy has lavender blue flowers from August to September atop white-margined green foliage. Partner either with a large, dark green-foliaged neighbor to make their leaves sparkle. Or choose companions that flower in the color of their variegation. The yellow blooms of Atlanta Moonlight daylily echo

long after the bracts have faded. green or blue hosta. Bonfire is aptly named with folibright pink.

blooming perennial, Lorraine spot. Sunshine False Sunflower (Heliopsis helianthoides) has white-veined green foliage. Planted in front of a dark green backdrop, it will stop visitors to your garden in their tracks.
