Supply List

- 24 to 30 Assorted Fabric strips at least 6" x 14". Be sure there is contrast between your fabrics in value or color or both.
 - Lights to Mediums to Darks
 - Warm (reds, oranges, yellows) and Cool Colors (blues, greens, purples).
- 1 Fat Quarter of a neutral fabric (black, gray, white, beige, brown)
- 1 Fat Quarter that contrasts & complements your assorted fabrics. It will be used to frame your blocks.
- Rotary cuttingsSupplies (small mat, rotary cutter, small ruler 3½" x 12½" & either a 6" Add a Quarter Ruler or a 2½" x ½" ruler)
- Sewing machine MUST BE IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION, and sewing supplies
 - Sewing machine, bobbins for the machine you are using, the machine's electrical cord, foot pedal, manual.
 - A sewing machine foot with a center cut out in front of the needle. Bring all your basic sewing machine feet, if you aren't sure.
 - Extra sewing machine needles 80/12 universal or top stitch or your preferred needle.
 - (There are a few sewing machines available to borrow. Let someone at Pacific Fabrics know if you need to reserve a machine).
- Thread Choose something in a medium shade value (medium gray, purple or green) 50 weight (Aurafil, Mettler or Dual Duty)
- Thread snips or small embroidery type scissors
- Seam Ripper
- Glass head straight pins (white or red heads. The blue ones bend)
- Pin cushion
- Scissors to be used to cut paper
- Fabric creaser (anything to help you crease back your pieces after they have been sewn in).

Optional Supplies:

- Small iron and ironing mat
- A paper piecing pattern you want to do, for discussion purposes
- Backing Fabric & Batting

Foundations to be provided in class (will be provided):

- Plum Easy Foundation Papers or EQ Printables Foundation Sheets
- Freezer paper
