- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Fabric Glue Stick Dritz Temporary Glue Stick PFC# 55758
- 5-10 fabrics of your choosing in 1/8 yard cuts or fat quarters. Can also be purchased the night of class once you pick out your pattern.
