Materials Needed:

HOOP: 5 x 7
 (Embroidery Field Needed: 5 x 6.89)
 Finished size: 4¾ x 6¾”

STABILIZER: Cut-away stabilizer

FABRIC:

Fabric 1: (main background)	1 Fat Sixteenth
Fabric 2: (small background)	scrap fabric
Fabric 3: (backing)	1 Fat Eighth
Fabric 4: (snowman face)	scrap fabric
Fabric 5: (hat)	scrap fabric
Fabric 6: (brim)	scrap fabric
Fabric 7: (carrot)	scrap fabric

OTHER:

Batting

A Fat Sixteenth is 9 x 11”
 A Fat Eighth is 9 x 21”

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1:	cut (1) 6 x 6” block
Fabric 2:	cut (1) 4 x 6” block
Fabric 3:	cut (2) 6 x 9” blocks
Fabric 4:	cut (1) 2½ x 6” block
Fabric 5:	cut (1) 2½ x 6” block
Fabric 6:	cut (1) 2½ x 6” block
Fabric 7:	cut (1) 1½ x 3” block
Batting:	cut (1) 6 x 8” block

Prepare the Following:

Fold both Fabric 3 (backing) pieces in half **wrong sides together**, aligning the 6” edges to make a 4½ x 6” block.



Embroider the Following:

1. Hoop stabilizer only in the appropriate size hoop.



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.



Indicates thread color change.
