Supply List

 $4" \times 11"$ Tan/Beige wool ~ background

2" x 2" gold wool ~ star

2" x 2" blue wool ~ star

2" x 2" red wool ~ heart


11/2" x 11/2" blue wool ~ flag canton

3" x 4" red wool ~ flag field

 $4'' \times 11''$ backing fabric of your choice

Embroidery threads: choose threads to match your wool colors. I used Valdani Perle Cotton #12 in these colors: Beige 0545, Red 078, Blue H2O7, and Gold 853

Steam A Seam 2 lite #24 chenille needle Glad Press N' Seal wrap Black Sharpie marker crushed walnut shells Dyed chenille trim ~ optional



Directions

- * Please note: designs at the top have been reversed. Trace the reversed appliques onto Steam a Seam 2. Cut out all applique shapes just outside the drawn line, and very lightly press onto wool colors. Cut each applique on the drawn line. Arrange the applique shapes as shown in the color photo and fuse to the background.
- * Stitch appliques using your choice of matching threads. You can blanket stitch or whip stitch the flag, stars and heart. I used gold thread on heart, blue thread on gold star, red thread on blue star, blue thread on flag field, and red thread on flag canton. Read the hint above for Press N' Seal and stem stitch the wavy flag lines in the flag field using beige thread. Straight stitch star in the flag canton using beige thread.
- * With right sides together, pin and sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and leave a 3" opening for turning. (You may find it helpful to use a walking foot.) Clip corners and turn pinkeep right side out. Stuff with crushed walnut shells, and stitch the opening closed. Whip stitch red dyed chenille trim over the seam if desired.
