Supply List

- ♥ 12" x 11" Light print for block background and Flying Geese
- ♥ 11" x 10" Red print for block, Flying Geese and borders.
- ♥ 11" x 10" Black print for block, Flying Geese and borders.
- ♥ 9½" × 10½" scrap of batting and backing fabric.
- $ilde{f v}$ (16) 2" $ilde{f x}$ Isosceles Triangle papers for English Paper Piecing (available from HeartspunQuilts.com)
- ♥ Scrap of fusible web.

$\underline{\text{Cutting Directions}} \sim \text{Cut in the order given}$

- *Cut (1) $10'' \times 10''$ square of light print for block background.
- *Cut (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of light print for Flying Geese Connector Corners.
- *Cut (1) $1^{\prime\prime}\times$ 10½" strip of red print for border.
- *Cut (1) $1'' \times 10''$ strip of red print for border.
- *Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red print rectangles for Flying Geese.

- *Cut (1) $1'' \times 9''$ strip of black print for border.
- *Cut (1) $1'' \times 81/2''$ strip of black print for border.
- *Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ " black print rectangles for Flying Geese.

* Prior knowledge of English Paper Piecing is assumed. *

Directions

★ Eight Pointed Star Block:

*Using remaining red and black print fabrics, glue or sew fabrics to individual Isosceles triangle papers and prepare (8) individual black print and (8) individual red print Isosceles Triangles.


*Sew (4) black print and (4) red print triangles into a circle.





- *Sew (4) black print and (4) red print triangles to the circle, alternating colors so red is sewn to black, and black is sewn to red, creating a star.
- *Remove the papers and sew the star block to the light print 10" background square by hand or machine.

Trim the square to $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



→ Flying Geese Units:

*Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " light print squares. Sew a light square, on the drawn line, to the left side of a black print $1\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle; press and trim. Repeat on the right side. Repeat to make (2) red print and (2) black print Flying Geese units measuring $1\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

*Refer to the color photo and sew the (4) Flying Geese units together, end to end: press seams open. Make (1) Flying Geese border measuring $1\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Sew the border to the star block: press to the star block.

+ Borders:

*Referring to the color photo, sew the borders to the mug rug quilt top Log Cabin style. Begin with the black $I'' \times 81/2''$ strip sewing it to the 81/2'' edge of the star block: in all cases, press to the border. Next, sew the red $I'' \times 10''$ strip to the bottom of the quilt, followed by the black $I'' \times 9''$ black strip to the Flying Geese edge, and ending with the $I'' \times 101/2''$ red strip on the top. Your quilt top should measure $91/2'' \times 101/2''$ unfinished.

→ Finishing Directions:

*Cut a 4" slit in the center of the backing fabric for turning.

*Layer the quilt top on the bottom, face up, then the batting, and lastly, layer the backing, face down. Pin on all four sides and sew the layers together along the raw edge using a 1/4" seam. Clip the corners and turn the quilt right side out through the slit in the backing: press. Using a scrap of backing fabric and fusible web, fuse the opening closed. Quilt as desired.
