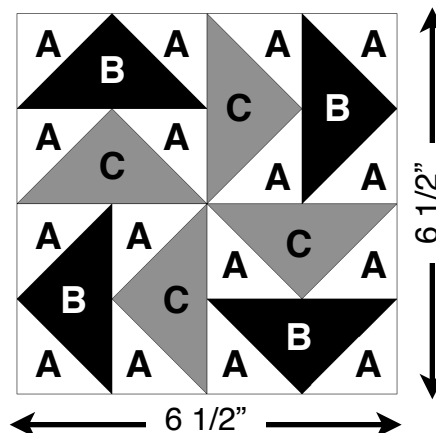
### Fall Mystery Block of the Week 2016

### Block 2/Week 2

These are the directions for block 2. We recommend that you print them for your own use. Please read through the entire instructions before beginning your block, referring to the color picture on page 3 as a guide for fabric placement.

#### Block 2

- A** Cut **16** (2") squares from a light print  
**B** Cut **4** (2" x 3 1/2") rectangles from a dark blue print  
**C** Cut **4** (2" x 3 1/2") rectangles from a dark brown print



#### Constructing Block 2

Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the light **A** squares.

With right sides together (RST), place a light **A** square onto a dark blue **B** rectangle . See diagram 1.

Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

Press to the light. See diagram 2.

Repeat, adding another light **A** square onto the dark blue **B** rectangle, sew and trim. See diagram 3.

Repeat for a total of 4 identical **A/B** flying geese block units.

Repeat the previous instructions using the remaining **A** squares and the **C** dark brown rectangles for a total of 4 identical **A/C** flying geese block units.

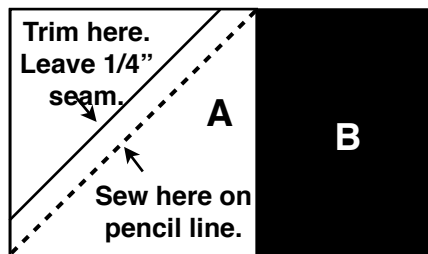

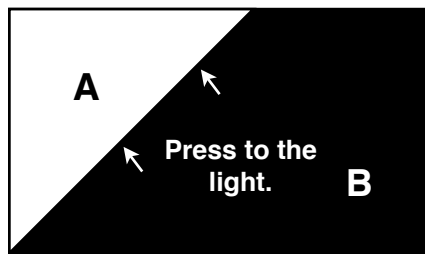

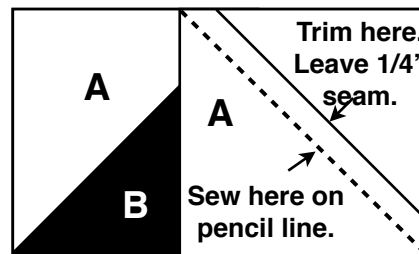
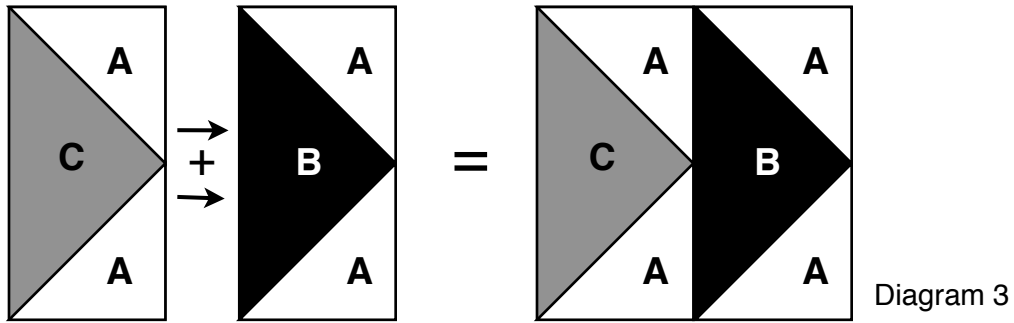


Diagram 3

Sew 1 **A/B** flying geese block unit and 1 **A/C** flying geese block unit together.  
 Press as indicated.  
 See diagram 4.  
 Repeat for a total of 4 identical flying geese block units.



Sew 4 flying geese block units together into two rows.  
 Press seams in the directions indicated.  
 Sew the rows together. See diagram 4.
