## Red Crinoline Quilts <br> Fall Mystery Block of the Week 2016 Block 6/Week 6

These are the directions for block 6. We recommend that you print them for your own use. Please read through the entire instructions before beginning your block, refering to the color picture on page 2 as a guide for fabric placement.

## Block 6

A Cut 5 (2 3/4") squares from a light print
B Cut 2 (2") squares from a light print
C Cut 1 (2 3/4") square from a light brown print
D Cut 2 (2") squares from a light brown print
E Cut 6 (2 3/4") squares from a dark blue print


## Constructing Block 6

With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $\mathbf{A}$ squares.
Place an $\mathbf{A}$ square and an $E$ square right sides together.
Sew $1 / 4 "$ on either side of the pencil line. See diagram 1.
Cut on the pencil line. See diagram 2.
Press to the dark. See diagram 3.
Trim to 2" square.
Repeat for a total of 10 identical A/E half-square triangles.
Repeat using the $\mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{E}$ squares making $2 \mathbf{C / E}$ half-square triangles.

Sew 10 A/E half-square triangles, 2 C/E half-square triangles, 2 lignt brown $\mathbf{D}$ squares and 2 light B squares together into 4 rows. Press as indicated by arrows.
Sew rows together. See diagram 4.
