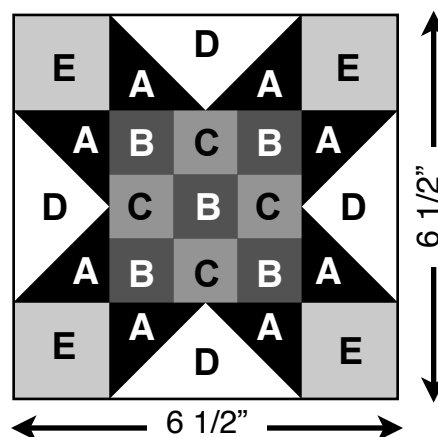


Red Crinoline Quilts  
Fall Mystery Block of the Week 2016  
Block 8/Week 8

These are the directions for block 8. We recommend that you print them for your own use. Please read through the entire instructions before beginning your block, referring to the color picture on page 3 as a guide for fabric placement.

### Block 8

- A** Cut **8** (2") squares from a dark brown print
- B** Cut **5** (1 1/2") squares from a brown print
- C** Cut **4** (1 1/2") squares from a light blue print
- D** Cut **4** (2" x 3 1/2") rectangles from a light print #1
- E** Cut **4** (2") squares from a light print #2



### Constructing Block 8

Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the dark brown **A** squares.

With right sides together (RST), place a dark brown **A** square onto a light **D** rectangle. See diagram 1.

Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

Press to the dark. See diagram 2.

Repeat, adding a dark brown **A** square onto a light **D** rectangle, sew and trim.

See diagram 3.

Repeat for a total of 4 identical flying geese block units.

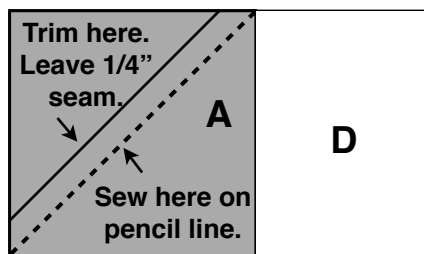

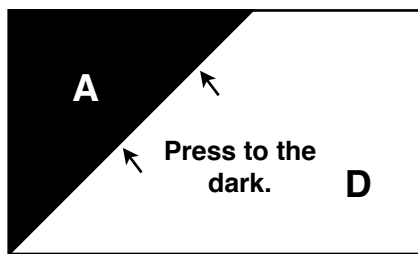

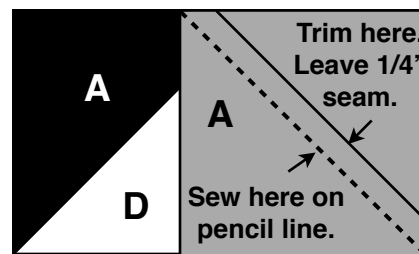


Diagram 3

Sew 5 brown **B** squares and 4 light blue **C** squares together into 3 rows. Press as indicated by arrows.

Sew the rows together. See diagram 4.

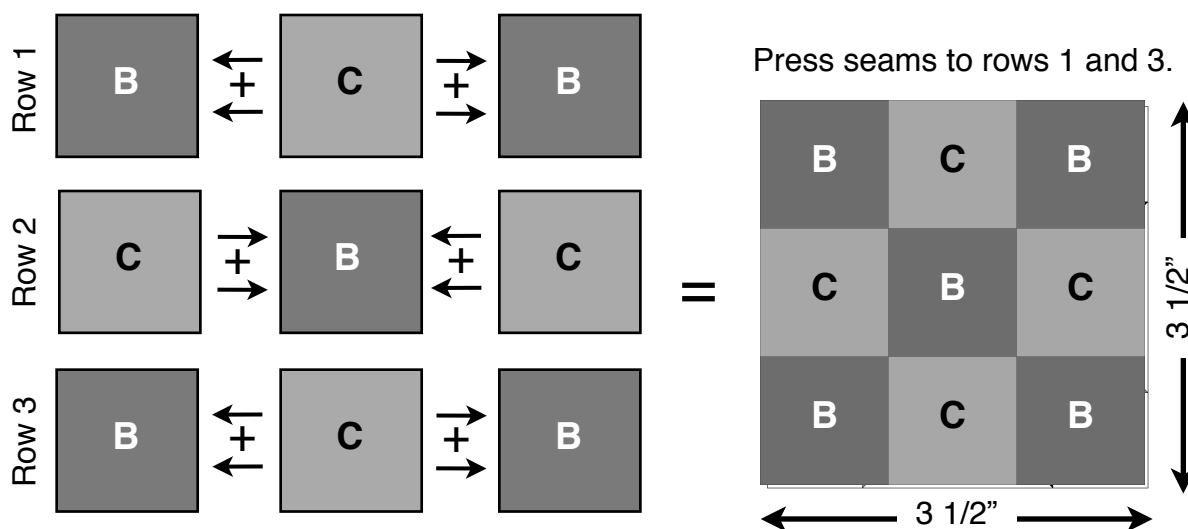

Sew 4 **E** squares, 4 flying geese block units, and 1 ninepatch block unit together into 3 rows. Press as indicated.

Sew the rows together. See diagram 5.

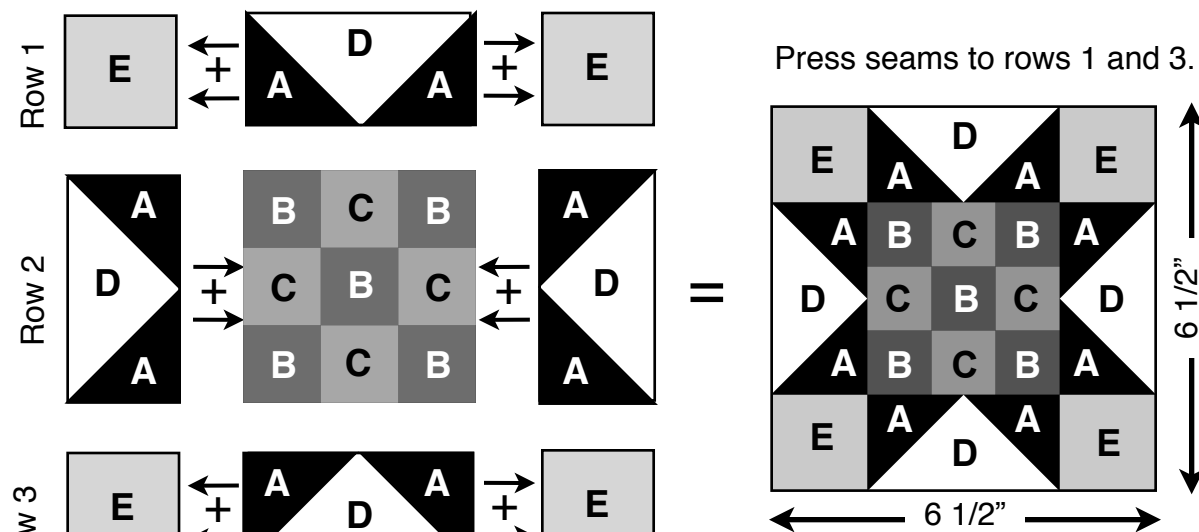
