## Red Crinoline Quilts <br> Fall Mystery Block of the Week 2016 Block 9/Week 9

These are the directions for block 9. We recommend that you print them for your own use. Please read through the entire instructions before beginning your block, refering to the color picture on page 3 as a guide for fabric placement.

## Block 9

A Cut 8 (1 1/2") squares from a brown print
B Cut 4 (1 1/2") squares from a brown print
C Cut 1 (2 1/2") square from a dark blue print
D Cut 4 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") rectangles from a blue print
E Cut 4 (1 1/2" x 4 1/2") rectangles from a light print
F Cut 4 (1 1/2") squares from a light print


## Constructing Block 9

Using a pencil, draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the brown A squares.
With right sides together (RST), place 2 brown $\mathbf{A}$ squares onto each end of a light $\mathbf{E}$ rectangle.
Sew on the pencil line and trim leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. See diagram 1.
Press to the dark. See diagram 2.
Repeat for a total of 4 identical pieced bar units.

Sew 4 brown $\mathbf{B}$ squares, 4 blue $\mathbf{D}$ rectangles and 1 dark blue $\mathbf{C}$ square together into 3 rows to create a ninepatch block unit. Press as indicated by arrows.
Sew the rows together. See diagram 3.


Sew 4 F squares, 4 pieced bar units, and 1ninepatch block unit together into 3 rows. Press as indicated.
Sew the rows together. See diagram 4.
